Coffee and Donuts in the Veterans Memorial Building –





Adjutant's Corner: Membership

WE DID IT! We beat our 2024 Membership Goal! As of the 26 January Weekly Report, we had 130 members paid for 2024. We still have 9 Annual members not renewed for 2024, **Please Renew NOW**. If you are having financial difficulties, let me know, we can do installments, or in extreme circumstances, the Post may pay your National and Department dues.

8 Annual members renewed in January, 3 of them online. 3 New members joined the Post, and 1 member Transferred In from CA Post 1000. No Members Transferred Out or to Post Everlasting.

<u>Dues Increase:</u> Current Post 18 Annual Dues are \$40. Of that, \$18.50 goes to National and \$15 goes to the Department of California (\$33.50), leaving the Post with \$6.50. At this year's National Convention, the National component of our dues was raised by \$5 to \$23.50, effective 1 July 2024 (Membership Year 2025). Rumor has it that at the March meeting, the Department Executive Committee will vote to RAISE Department Dues by either \$2.50 or \$5.00. If any dues increase passes, the Post will also have to raise dues for 2025, probably to \$45 or \$50 per year, as our Bylaws require Post dues cannot be less than the sum of National and Department dues.

Paid-Up-For-Life (PUFL) members, and those who upgrade to PUFL status before 1 July 2024, will not be affected by these increases. Multi-year renewals are now available: If you renew online at legion.org you may renew for up to 3 years at the current rate.
